Date		Prayer Point
1	Joel 2:12-14	Turn to God with all your heart during Lenten season.
2	Hosea 10:12	Seek the Lord and may your heart always break in His presence.
3	Isaiah 55:6-7	Receive God's mercy and overflowing pardon.
4	Daniel 9:3	Seek inward things, pray Lenten prayers, asking for mercy.
5	Ezekiel 18:21	Turn away from sin and receive the abundant life that is in Christ.
6	1 Peter 5:6	Humble yourself before the Lord and be exalted by Him.
7	1 Samuel 15:22	God takes great delight in your obedience to Him.
8	Matthew 4:1-2	Jesus mixed fasting with His prayer to obey God and carry out His earthly assignment.
9	Colossians 3:1-5	Because you are risen with Christ, seek the things of God.
10	Mark 1:12-13	Embrace wilderness: time to be alone, be tested and grow in faith.
11	Isaiah 58:6	Let God choose the fast for you that we may be set free in every area of your life.
12	Lamentations 3:25-26	God is good to those who hope in Him and seek Him. It is good for you to wait on Him.
13	Psalms 130:5-6	Let us observe and implement King David's example of waiting for God.
14	Jeremiah 29:12-13	As you call out to God, may you do it with all your heart.
15	James 4:8	As you draw near to God, He will draw near to you.
16	1 Chronicles 16:11	Seek God continually and help others to do the same.
17	Acts 3:19	Repent, turn away from sin and turn to the Savior.
18	2 Peter 3:9	God wants you to come to repentance. Be grateful for God's patience with you.
19	Acts 2:38	Repent, be baptized and receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
20	Romans 2:4	May God's kindness steer you to true repentance.
21	1 John 1:8-9	God only asks that you confess your sin to receive His forgiveness and purification.
22	2 Chronicles 7:14	God's people receive forgiveness and healing when you pray, seek God's face and turn from sin.
23	Acts 11:18	God has granted repentance to you that leads to His abundant life
24	Proverbs 28:13	Concealing sin yields a lack of prosperity. Confessing sin yields mercy.
25	Mark 1:15	We have been given a simple instruction, "Repent and believe the good news".
26	Luke 15:7	As you draw close to God, also pray for the lost to repent and turn to God.
27	John 3:16	Remember the ultimate sacrifice and suffering of Jesus Christ.
28	Luke 9:23	As disciples deny yourself, take up your cross, and follow Christ.
29	Hebrews 13:15	Think on the great sacrifice of God in offering up His only son and offer the sacrifice of praise.
30	Psalms 42:1	May you have a thirst for God always and seek Him continuously.
31	Hosea 6:6	Draw close to God be mindful that the Father desires that you know Him and love Him.
